### **Fiji looks to the Commonwealth**

*The Ministry of Lands and Mineral Resources is looking to the Commonwealth countries in its efforts to formulate its own Fiji Lands Valuation Act.*

This was highlighted by the Ministry’s permanent secretary, Malakai Finau, while delivering the keynote address at the Commonwealth Heads of Valuation Agencies conference meeting in Nadi yesterday.

Finau says the conference paves the opportunity for the ministry to hear presentations which involve ways the various agencies have improved valuation outcomes as the Government looks to formulate the Fiji Land Valuation Act.

He adds the conference sets the platform for conducive discussions focusing on shaping the valuation profession for the future of all Commonwealth nations.

Finau says Fiji can revert to specifically design suitable policy and operational needs of valuation agencies such as the Chief Valuers Office and Valuation Division of Fiji.
